Rules of the 15th Trumpet Competition of Isle sur la Sorgue,

Sunday, April 5, 2020

- Article 1: The municipal school of music of Isle sur la Sorgue (France), organizes a trumpet contest on Sunday, April 5, 2020.
- **Article 2**: This contest is open to trumpeters under 30 years of age. For minor competitors, parental permission is imperative. An ID may be requested.
- **Article 3**: There are 6 categories:
 - Beginner: candidates born after 01/01/09
 - Preparatory: candidates born after 01/01/07
 - Elementary: candidates born after 01/01/05
 - Medium: candidates born after 01/01/2002
 - Superior: candidates born after 01/01/98
 - Excellence: candidates born after 01/01/90
- Article 4: Works are taxed according to age categories. Candidates must respect the proposed editions.
- **Article 5:** Category Excellence: to be selected, the inscription must be accompanied by a timed list of the interpreted works, duration between 12 and 15 minutes counting at least 2 pieces of different aesthetic, accompanied by the corresponding scores (trumpet + piano) where appropriate. The candidate will have to interpret his works with obligatorily 2 different instruments (trumpet Ut, Bb, Eb, cornet, bugle ...). For this category, the jury reserves the right to stop the candidate in the middle of the program. Attention, the program registered on the registration form can not be modified. The acknowledgment of receipt email is the definitive validation of said program.
- Article 6: According to the imposed piece, the accompaniment "piano" is obligatory. Candidates can come with the pianist of their choice.

For rehearsals, contact the Secretariat of the Municipal School of Music until 22 March 2020, who will send you the details of the official guide. (Only the accompaniment on the day of the contest is free).

- **Article 7**: The use of photocopies (trumpet and piano accompaniment) is prohibited.
- **Article 8:** The registration fee of $40 \in$ will be made by check payable to the "Régie School of Music". Only candidates who have paid the registration fee will be called.
- **Article 9:** Registration must be done by mail on the registration form provided, to:

No registration will be done by phone

- **Article 10:** The number of places being limited (quota of a number of candidates in each category), late registrations may not be accepted ... In this case, the check of $40 \in$ will be returned. This quota can be modified by the organizer for the purposes of the day. No registration will be accepted after the 1st of February 2020, postmarked as proof.
- Article 11: Any successful candidate from a previous session can not be represented in the same category.
- Article 12: In response to the registration, the candidate will be invited to the competition by email specifying the time and place of the event.
- Article 13: All commitment is final. In case of withdrawal, the candidate will not be reimbursed for any registration fees.
- Article 14: All travel expenses are borne by the candidates.
- Article 15: The jury is made up of instrument specialists and personalities from the music world. His decision is irrevocable.
- Article 16: The award ceremony will be done at the end of the day, at the end of the tests.

A trophy will be awarded by the jury to the winner with the highest score, all categories combined. All candidates will receive a medal and a diploma. The organization reserves the right not to distribute all the prizes if the artistic level or the number of candidates of the category does not justify it.

- **Article 17:** The organizers decline any responsibility in case of accident not related to the organization of the contest, the candidates being at the expense of the parents or guides. The municipality organizing the contest can not dismiss any responsibility. Any incident related to this organization and throughout the duration of the contest will be the responsibility of the municipality. It is provided for this purpose.
- Article 18: Participation in the contest includes parental or tutorial permission to use the image rights on the contest website and any other communication support useful for the promotion of this event.
- Article 19: Unless authorized exceptionally, audio or video recordings are prohibited.
- Article 20: Participation in the contest implies full acceptance of the present rules.
